

Washington, D.C. Alumni Chapter of Mu Phi Epsilon Scholarship Competition for Graduate Music Students

Awards up to **\$1300**

Competition Date: **April 10, 2010**

Application Deadline: **March 13, 2010**

Eligibility

1. Applicants **need not be members of Mu Phi Epsilon**, but must either be:
 - (a) **Graduating seniors**, currently enrolled in a Maryland/D.C./Virginia/West Virginia-area music program, who are continuing their education at the graduate level next semester in an accredited college or university; or
 - (b) **Graduate-level students** (Master's or Doctorate) currently enrolled and continuing a music degree at an accredited college or university in the Maryland/D.C./Virginia/West Virginia area.
2. Open to performers in voice, piano, organ, harp, strings, woodwinds, brass and percussion.
3. Applicants must have a grade point average (GPA) of "B" or above in music subjects and a "C" or above in all other subjects.

Award money must be used for Fall 2010-Spring 2011 study toward an approved graduate music degree, scheduling at least 8 credits for the Fall 2010 semester. Awards for graduating seniors can be applied to further study without restrictions to locale. Money will be awarded after proof of registration is received.

Requirements

1. Applicants must submit the following items in **one packet**, postmarked **no later than March 13, 2010**:
 - a. Completed application form (**downloadable from www.muphiepsilon.org/washingtondcalumni**).
 - b. Official college transcript through the Fall 2009 semester (no grade sheet allowed).
 - c. Two letters of recommendation in sealed envelopes:
 - one from the applicant's applied music teacher, and
 - one from another appropriate professional of the applicant's choice.
 - d. A list of repertoire to be performed with exact timings. Audition time is 15 minutes.
 - Three contrasting works representing at least three periods of music. Pianists and other instrumentalists are required to perform one movement of a sonata. Singers' repertoire must include one song in English and two songs in two other languages. One vocal selection must be from an opera or oratorio.
 - e. A short personal history including names of teachers, performing experience, honors, organizations and other facts.
 - f. A signed Music Reproduction Waiver form. (**downloadable from www.muphiepsilon.org/washingtondcalumni**).

**Rules and regulations regarding this competition are firm. There will be no exceptions. All prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the judges. Additional prizes may be awarded, divided, or prize monies withheld.
The decision of the judges is final.**

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

1. Pianists and organists must perform all music **from memory**. Singers must perform opera arias **from memory**. Instrumentalists must perform music **from memory**, except for accompanied sonatas.
2. Provide **your own accompanist**.
3. Performers must use at least **one original copy** of each composition. Legally downloaded scores and photocopies allowed only for judges and after release waiver has been signed.
4. Include a **self-addressed, stamped envelope** if you wish any of the materials to be returned.
